Ch.Vineela III B.Com (Voc) topped the University in B.Com and also received Prathiba Award.

## CEO Report

The examinations for the academic year 2018-19 were organized and conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of AKNU Controller of Examinations. Internal examinations, practical and Semester end theory examinations were conducted as per the university academic calendar.

I, III & IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of November/December 2018 and II, IV & VI Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of March/April 2019. Examination centre was allotted by the COE of AKNU. Those centers were degree colleges affiliated to AKNU, which were located in and around Eluru. The results were declared by COE of AKNU through official website.

For the I Semester end theory exams 569 B.Sc students and 164 B.Com students attended the examination among them 409 B.sc students and 131 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 72 and 80 respectively.

For the II Semester end theory exams 548 B.Sc students and 161 B.Com students attended the examination among them 469 B.sc students and 124 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 86 and 77 respectively.

For the III Semester end theory exams 441 B.Sc students and 144 B.Com students attended the examination among them 345 B.sc students and 113 B.Com students passed with 78 percentages.

For the IV Semester end theory exams 433 B.Sc students and 138 B.Com students attended the examination among them 355 B.sc students and 123 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 82 and 89 respectively.

In the V Semester end theory exams 350 B.Sc students and 143 B.Com students attended the examination among them 279 B.sc students and 130 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 80 and 82 respectively.

In the VI Semester end theory exams 347 B.Sc students and 143 B.Com students attended the examination among them 326 B.sc students and 141 B.Com students passed with an excellent percentage of 94 and 99 respectively.

The result of M.Sc Organic Chemistry was encouraging. For I & II semester exams 19 students appeared among them 9 students passed I sem and 5 students II sem with 47% and 26% respectively. For III & IV semester exams 19 students appeared among them

17 passed III sem and 18 passed in IV sem with a good percentage of 89.4 and 94.7 respectively.
