## CEO Report

The examinations for the academic year 2019-20 were organized and conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of AKNU Controller of Examinations. Internal examinations, practicals and semester end examinations were conducted as per the university academic calendar.

I, III & IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of November/December 2019 and II, IV & VI Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of March/April 2020. Examination centre was allotted by the COE of AKNU. Those centers were degree colleges affiliated to AKNU, which were located in and around Eluru. The results were declared by COE of AKNU through official website.

For the I Semester end theory exams 514 B.Sc students and 152 B.Com students attended the examination among them 405 B.sc students and 142 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 79 and 87 respectively.

For the II Semester end theory exams 494 B.Sc students and 144 B.Com students attended the examination among them 357 B.sc students and 132 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 72 and 92 respectively.

For the III Semester end theory exams 537 B.Sc students and 152 B.Com students attended the examination among them 478 B.sc students and 118 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 89 and 78 percentages respectively.

For the IV Semester end theory exams 526 B.Sc students and 145 B.Com students attended the examination among them 406 B.Sc students and 128 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 77 and 88 respectively.

In the V Semester end theory exams 434 B.Sc students and 136 B.Com students attended the examination among them 399 B.sc students and 118 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 92 and 87 respectively.

In the VI Semester end theory exams 422 B.Sc students and 137 B.Com students attended the examination among them 405 B.sc students and 137 B.Com students passed with an excellent percentage of 96 and 100 respectively. Five of our B.Sc MPC students namely P.Sailaja, Ch.Kusumanjali, M.Krishna Prasanna, T.Akhila, and Rehana Begum stood as University toppers.

The result of M.Sc Organic Chemistry was encouraging. For I & II semester exams 25 students appeared among them 15 students passed I sem and 17 students II sem with 60 and 68 respectively. For III & IV semester exams 18 students appeared among them 15 passed III sem and 11 passed in IV sem with a good percentage of 83 and 61 respectively.
