CEO Report

The examinations for the academic year 2020-21 were organized and conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of AKNU Controller of Examinations. Internal examinations, practical and Semester end theory examinations were conducted as per the university academic calendar.

I, III & IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months August/March 2021 and II, IV & VI Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of September/ October/November 2021. Examination centre was allotted by the COE of AKNU. Those centers were degree colleges affiliated to AKNU, which were located in and around Eluru. The results were declared by COE of AKNU through official website.

For the I Semester end theory exams 476 B.Sc students and 147 B.Com students attended the examination among them 342 B.sc students and 132 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 72 and 90 respectively.

For the II Semester end theory exams 466 B.Sc students and 144 B.Com students attended the examination among them 351 B.sc students and 132 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 75 and 92 respectively.

For the III Semester end theory exams 467 B.Sc students and 136 B.Com students attended the examination among them 406 B.sc students and 134 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 87 & 99 respectively.

For the IV Semester end theory exams 465 B.Sc students and 139 B.Com students attended the examination among them 360 B.sc students and 122 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 77 and 88 respectively.

In the V Semester end theory exams 519 B.Sc students and 142 B.Com students attended the examination among them 459 B.sc students and 134 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 88 and 94 respectively.

In the VI Semester end theory exams 517 B.Sc students and 140 B.Com students attended the examination among them 455 B.sc students and 135 B.Com students passed with an excellent percentage of 88 and 96 respectively.

The result of M.Sc Organic Chemistry was encouraging. For I & II semester exams 11 students appeared among them 5 students passed I sem and 3 students passed II sem with 45 % and 27% respectively. For III & IV semester exams 25 students appeared among them 22 passed III sem and 16 passed in IV sem with a good percentage of 88 and 64 respectively
