CEO Report

The examinations for the academic year 2021-22 were organized and conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of AKNU controller of examinations. Internal examinations, practicals and semester end examinations were conducted as per the university academic calendar.

I, III & IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months March /November 2022 and II, IV & VI Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of September/ July 2022. Examination centre was allotted by the COE of AKNU. Those centers were degree colleges affiliated to AKNU, which were located in and around Eluru. The results were declared by COE of AKNU through official website.

For the I Semester end theory exams 519 B.Sc students and 146 B.Com students attended the examination among them 436 B.sc students and 136 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 84 and 94 respectively.

For the II Semester end theory exams 502 B.Sc students and 141 B.Com students attended the examination among them 443 B.sc students and 129 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 88 and 92 respectively.

For the III Semester end theory exams 459 B.Sc students and 143 B.Com students attended the examination among them 429 B.sc students and 126 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 93 & 88 respectively.

For the IV Semester end theory exams 452 B.Sc students and 140 B.Com students attended the examination among them 397 B.sc students and 130 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 88 and 93 respectively.

In the V Semester end theory exams 456 B.Sc students and 130 B.Com students attended the examination among them 392 B.sc students and 130 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 86 and 100 respectively.

In the VI Semester end theory exams 454 B.Sc students and 130 B.Com students attended the examination among them 412 B.sc students and 128 B.Com students passed with an excellent percentage of 91 and 98 respectively.

The result of M.Sc Organic Chemistry was encouraging. For I & II semester exams 22 students appeared among them 08 students passed I sem and 10 students passed II sem with 36 % and 45% respectively. For III & IV semester exams 11 students appeared among them 05 passed III sem and 08 passed in IV sem with a good percentage of 45 and 73 respectively
