CEO Report

The examinations for the academic year 2022-23 were organized and conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of AKNU Controller of Examinations. Internal examinations, practicals and semester end examinations were conducted as per the university academic calendar.

I, III & IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months March /April 2023 and II, IV Semester end theory examinations were conducted in the months of August / July 2023. In the VI semester long term internship was evaluated. Examination centre was allotted by the COE of AKNU. Those centers were degree colleges affiliated to AKNU, which were located in and around Eluru. The results were declared by COE of AKNU through official website.

For the I Semester end theory exams 291 B.Sc students and 155 B.Com students attended the examination among them 263 B.sc students and 144 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 90 and 93 respectively.

For the II Semester end theory exams 289 B.Sc students and 152 B.Com students attended the examination among them 247 B.sc students and 144 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 85 and 93 respectively.

For the III Semester end theory exams 500 B.Sc students and 140 B.Com students attended the examination among them 472 B.sc students and 136 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 94 & 97 respectively.

For the IV Semester end theory exams 496 B.Sc students and 140 B.Com students attended the examination among them 434 B.sc students and 129 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 88 and 92 respectively.

For the V Semester end theory exams 445 B.Sc students and 140 B.Com students attended the examination among them 424 B.sc students and 127 B.Com students passed with a good percentage of 95 and 91

In the VI Semester Long term Internship evaluation was done for 445 B.Sc students with 99% result and 140 B.Com students with 100% result.

The result of M.Sc Organic Chemistry was encouraging. For I & II semester exams 06 students appeared among them 05 students passed I sem and 04 students passed II sem with 83 % and 67 % respectively. For III & IV semester exams 22 students appeared among them 20 passed III sem and 16 passed in IV sem with a good percentage of 91 and 73 respectively.
